Your packet will be available at all the orientation sessions which will be held Saturday, June 25, 2011 at 11:00am; Monday, June 27, 2011 at 6:00pm and Saturday, July 9, 2011 at 11:00am. If you cannot make it to one of those sessions to pick up your packet, you will be able to pick it up at the 4-H Extension Office in New Bloomfield from Wednesday, June 29, 2011 through Thursday, July 7, 2011.
